

REGULAR MEETING MINUTES
VILLAGE OF GOREVILLE
July 1, 2019

On July 1, 2019 at 6:00 PM, Mayor pro-tem Don Kerley called the regular board meeting to order. The Village Clerk, Agnes Paul conducted roll call. The following trustees were present: Trustee Johnson, Trustee Beckmann, Trustee Trovillion, and Trustee Jones.

Others present at the meeting were: Treasurer, Jackie Pritchett, Police Chief, Eddie Holland, Attorney, Elvis Cameron, Pam Perry, Mike Green, Sam Mighell, Fire Chief, Randy Childers and Chuck Querry (sign in sheet attached)

Trustee Trovillion motioned to approve the minutes of the June 3, 2019 regular meeting the treasurer's report, and the paid bills for June totaling: **\$143,872.30**. General Fund = **\$48,461.13** , TIF # 1= **\$48,560.85**, TIF #2 = **\$46,560.32**. Trustee Johnson seconded the motion. Trustee Beckmann abstained from the vote. All others voted yes.

Treasurer, Jackie Pritchett presented to and briefed the board on the annual financial report that she had prepared. It displayed a detailed financial picture

Trustee Beckmann motioned to approve Ordinance # 2020-1 an ordinance vacating a portion of "Old Route 37" loop, which runs adjacent to route 37 South in Goreville. Trustee Trovillion seconded the motion. All voted yes.



The offer to purchase of property adjacent to the park for \$15,000.00 was accepted and the land transfer will take place this month.


Trustee Beckmann asked for help with setting up and cleaning up on July 4th.
