

REGULAR MEETING MINUTES

VILLAGE OF GOREVILLE

June 2, 2025

On June 2, 2025, at 6:02 PM, Mayor Vaughn called the regular board meeting to order. The Village Clerk conducted roll call, and the following trustees were present: Trustee McNamara, Trustee Beckmann, Trustee Billingsley, Trustee Sullivan, and Trustee Johnson. Mayor Vaughn was present.

Others present at the meeting were Sam Mighell, Pam Perry, Ryne McNally, and Kevin Fear. Trustee Beckmann motioned to approve the minutes of May 5, 2025, regular meeting and the treasurer report for April 2025, and the paid bills for May 2025 totaling:

Trustee Billingsley seconded the motion. All voted yes, and the motion carried.

The Board reviewed monthly reports submitted by the police department as well as the water, sewer, and fire department. All the reports are attached and filed with these minutes.

Chief McNally informed the Board that the new Pumper Tanker will be completed by the end of July. Informed the Board of the sale of SCBA bottles to the Pope County Fire Department.

Water Superintendent Mighell presented a quote for IMCO for \$2882 for an Automatic Hydrate Flusher. Trustee Sullivan made a motion to approve the purchase of the AHF for \$2882. Trustee McNamara seconded the motion. All voted yes, and the motion carried.

Mr. Mighell also presented two quotes for a new grapple for the tractor and backhoe. This purchase would help with the cleanup process each year. Trustee Beckmann made a motion to approve the quote for \$4,900 for a new grapple for the tractor. Trustee Billingsley seconded the motion. All voted yes, and the motion carried.

Kevin Fear presented to opportunity for the employees, Board of Trustees, Police Department and volunteer Fire Department to become members of Air Evac. Membership will be revised on a yearly basis. Trustee Sullivan made a motion to approve the \$75 yearly membership for Air Evac for each employee. Trustee Beckmann seconded the motion. All voted yes, and the motion carried.

Mayor Vaughn presented a quote for C&C Prostripe. This quote is to stripe the Village Hall to lessen the confusion when parking at the Village. Trustee Beckmann made a motion to approve the quote from C&C Prostripe for \$2,800. Trustee Sullivan seconded the motion. All voted yes, and the motion carried.

Sam Mighell and Mayor Vaughn provided a quote for the baseball lights to be installed. The Brown Electric quote is \$7,500 to \$ 10,500. Trustee Beckmann made a motion to approve the quote for Brown Electric to install the baseball field lights utilizing TIF funds.

Clerk Chrisman presented ordinance 2026-1 an ordinance providing for and approving the first amendment to the Goreville TIF District 2 Redevelopment Project Area, Plan and Projects. Trustee Beckmann made a motion to approve 2026-1. Trustee Sullivan seconded the motion. All voted yes, and the motion passed.

Clerk Chrisman all provided ordinance 2026-2 an ordinance updating our current TIF agreement for the next year for the three TIF Districts. Trustee Billingsley made a motion to approve ordinance 2026-2. Trustee Beckmann seconded the motion. All voted yes, and the motion carried.

Next Clerk Chrisman proposed changing the current committees that are put in place. The proposal is all attached in the minutes. Trustee Beckmann made a motion to approve proposed committees. Trustee McNamara seconded to motion. All voted yes, and the motion carried.

Treasurer Maze presented an opportunity to upgrade current computers in the office. She provided two quotes from Advanced Computer Tech. Trustee Beckmann made a motion to approve the quote for \$1,011.50 totaling \$6,069 for all the computers in the office. Trustee Sullivan seconded the motion. All voted yes and the motion carried.

Water Clerk Pam Perry informed the Board that the past fiscal year the Village was at a 17.5% loss. The cost of postage, testing, and meters as well as other necessary items needed to properly provide adequate drinking water has increased. Attached is the rate increase that was proposed. Trustee Sullivan made a motion to approve the water & sewer rates attached to these minutes. Trustee Beckmann seconded the motion. Trustee Billingsley and Trustee McNamara voted yes. Trustee Johnson abstained.

The Fleet Fab Quote was tabled.

Clerk Chrisman presented resolution 2026-3 for the 4th of July Parade Permit. Trustee Beckmann made a motion to approve 2026-3. Trustee Billingsley seconded the motion. All voted yes and the motion carried.

At 8:25 PM, Trustee Billingsley made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Trustee Sullivan seconded the motion. All voted yes, and the motion carried.
