

REGULAR MEETING MINUTES
VILLAGE OF GOREVILLE

April 6, 2026

On April 6, 2026, at 6:05 PM, Mayor Vaughn called the regular board meeting to order. The Village Clerk conducted roll call, and the following Trustees were present: Trustee Beckmann, Trustee Sullivan, Trustee Johnson, Trustee Patterson, Trustee McNamara and Mayor Vaughn. Trustee Schaefer was absent.

Elle Mobley, Nate Kaminskis and Misty Blackstone attended the meeting. Trustee Beckmann moved to approve the regular session minutes from March 2, 2026, the Treasurer's reports from February 2026; and the paid bills for March 2026. **Total: \$80,172.25**

Trustee Sullivan seconded the motion. Trustee. All voted yes, the motion passed.

Chief Goines gave an update about the installation of the axon cameras. He also informed the Board that the Goreville School has kindly donated the Black 2013 Ford Taurus back to the Village.

The Water Superintendent reported to the Board that the EPA inspection was successfully completed and passed.

GFI Digital shared their company history and noted their Marion service location. The HP DJ T2600 costs \$9,485.43, with three quotes included in the minutes. Trustee Sullivan moved to approve GFI's quote for \$9,485.43 using TIF funds. Trustee Patterson seconded the motion. All voted yes, and the motion carried.

The Mayor proposed a plan for ditching and excavating for the public works department. He informed the Board that we have earned roughly \$45,000 in interest from our TIF funds and he would like to utilize those funds to purchase an excavator for the department. The Board asked that the Clerk put out a Bid for a mini excavator.

Trustee Sullivan made a motion to donate the old Fire Department Rescue Vehicle to the Cypress Fire Department. Trustee Beckmann seconded the motion. All voted yes, and the motion carried.

Fire Chief McNally informed the Board that the Fleet Fab quote for \$5188.00 would be covered by the Foreign Fire Tax Fund and requested that the Village paid for the quote from Wesley's Custom Graphics for \$2200. This would be for the Logo and Vehicle identification and station

decals. Trustee Sullivan made a motion to approve the quote for \$2200. Trustee Patterson seconded the motion. All voted yes, and the motion carried.

Clerk Chrisman presented quotes from SI Waste Container & from Waste Wizard both attached in the minutes. Trustee Sullivan made a motion to approve the quote from SI Waste Container for \$2,200 for Spring Clean up on May 30th & 31st. Trustee McNamara seconded the motion. All voted yes, and the motion passed.

Trustee Johnson made a motion to pass Ordinance 2026-6a, our annual Parade Route Ordinance required for an IDOT permit for road closures. Trustee Beckmann seconded the motion. All voted yes, and the motion carried.

Fire Chief McNally informed the Board of outstanding bill owed to the Fire Department.

Clerk Chrisman notified the Board that Landon Albright applied for a TIF project; however, the Board declined the proposal.

At 7:40 PM, Trustee Sullivan made a motion to enter executive session. Trustee McNamara seconded the motion. All voted yes, and the motion passed.

At 8:06 PM, Trustee Sullivan made a motion to exit executive session. Trustee McNamara seconded the motion. All voted yes, and the motion carried.


