On May 4, 2026, at 6:02 PM, Mayor Vaughn called the regular board meeting to order. The Village Clerk conducted roll call, and the following Trustees were present: Trustee Beckmann, Trustee Sullivan, Trustee Johnson, Trustee Patterson, Trustee McNamara, Trustee Shaefer and Mayor Vaughn. Trustee Patterson was absent.

Elvis Cameron, Doug Ratermann and Parveen Sunny attended the meeting. Trustee Beckmann moved to approve the regular session minutes from April 6, 2026, the Treasurer's reports from March 2026; and the paid bills for April 2026. **Total: \$53,547.07**

Trustee Sullivan seconded the motion. Trustee. All voted yes, the motion passed.

The Mayor moved to new business to allow the Villages engineers present the Motor Fuel Budget. Trustee Beckmann made a motion to approve the 2026 MFT Budget Resolution for 65,000. Trustee Beckmann McNamara seconded the motion. All voted yes, and the motion carried.

Trustee Sullivan made a motion to approve the invoice for Airmed to renewal all memberships for all the employees and board members. Trustee Johnson seconded the motion. All voted yes, and the motion carried.


Treasurer Maze and clerk Chrisman proposed hiring a part-time employee for accounts payable. They recommended posting the position with a salary range of \$18 to \$20 per hour. They suggested advertising for a new part-time treasurer so that Michelle Maze's retirement transition would be easier. The treasurer position will be listed at \$1,000 per month. Trustee Johnson made a motion to approve both part time positions to be posted as recommended. Trustee Sullivan seconded the proposal. Everyone voted in favor, so the motion passed.


Clerk Chrisman informed the Board of a new Part time applicant that had applied for the police department. Trustee Sullivan made a motion to approve the clerk to call a committee meeting to conduct a formal interview with the applicant. Trustee McNamara seconded the motion. All voted yes, and the motion passed.

Clerk Chrisman moved on to the sealed bid for the mini excavator. There was one sealed bid that had been submitted. Trustee Beckmann made a motion to accept the bid from Suits Rental Equipment for \$39,500. Trustee McNamara seconded the motion. All voted yes, and the motion carried.

The clerk quoted \$2400 for 8 iPads for Board meetings and other business needs. Trustee McNamara made a motion to approve the quote for \$2400 for the new iPads. Trustee Beckmann seconded the motion. All voted yes, and the motion passed.

At 7:08 PM, Trustee Sullivan moved to exit and adjourn. Trustee Schaefer seconded the motion. All voted yes, and the motion carried.
